## Notes

1) The timeline starts at the year 0 being the creation of Adam. All subsequent dates are referred to as AA (After Adam).
2) The terminology "after the flood" refers to 1656 as the starting point. We get this calculation by referencing when Noah was born to the total number of years he lived (950). The same terminology used in Genesis 9:28 is also used in Genesis 11:10 to refer to the birth of Arphaxad. The proper context, based on the calculations, seems to be "after the flood began" and not "after the flood ended" as we might use the phrase in our time.
3) Abraham enters Canaan in 2023 AA, which is exactly 215 years before Jacob meets Pharaoh and moves to Egypt in 2238 AA.
4) If the time of the Judges begins with the raising up of Moses to deliver Israel ( 2413 AA ) and ends with the beginning of the reign of Saul (2859), it gives us a total of 446 years of Judges. This timeframe would reconcile perfectly with Paul's timeframe of "about the space of 450 years" in Acts 13.
a. If Paul's timeframe begins after the death of Joshua ( 2543 AA ), the longest the period of the Judges could've lasted would be 316 years.
5) $B C$ and $A D$ dates are calculated starting with the reign of King David, which is believed to have started 1010 1000 BC . All BC and AD calculations are centered around this date.

## Interesting Observations

The following observations do not represent doctrine, but are observations made by viewing this timeline. Feel free to double check them and see what else you notice about the timeline.

1. The total number of sons and daughters is not given for any of the names listed in Genesis 5 , except for Noah.
2. 1657 - The details of Noah's life are given up to just a few years after the flood, but he lived another 350 years after the flood. We aren't given those details.
3. 2006 - Abraham was 58 years old when Noah died.
4. 2023 - Abraham moved to Canaan 60 years before his father Terah died in 2083 AA.
5. 2088 - Isaac married Rebekah 3 years after the death of his mother Sarah.
6. 2158 - Shem outlives Abraham by 35 years.
7. 2158 - Jacob and Esau were 50 years old when Shem died.
8. 2373 - Moses was the great grandson of Levi.
a. Levi fathered Kohath who fathered Amram who fathered Moses.
b. This timeframe does not leave enough time for a 400 -year enslavement in Egypt.
9. 2493 - Aaron and Moses die the same year.
10. 2968 / 2969 - These entries seem to be a rounding of dates to whole numbers instead of exact months. Example: 40 years instead of 39 years and 7 months.
11. 2988 / 2989 - The ending of 2 Chronicles 13:20-22 seems to indicate that Abijah lived for an unspecified amount of time after the war, but we are not told how long. The text does not mention his death at that battle, nor are we told how old he was when he died. This could potentially result in the timeline being off by a few months to a few years.
